Housing Minister offers condolences to the Mohammed family

Minister of Housing and Urban Development Camille Robinson-Regis has expressed condolences to the Mohammed family following the death of their relatives, Imtiaz and Imraz Mohammed.

The Trinidad and Tobago Housing Development Corporation (HDC) understands that the two men were murdered following a fracas with a neighbour at Building 16, Oropune Gardens on Saturday, March 30, 2024. The victims' relative Nazeera Mohammed and a neighbour, Nicholas Dimantos, who were also injured during the attack, are receiving treatment at the Hospital.

Mrs Robinson-Regis described the incident as unfortunate and preventable, adding that the HDC strives to provide safe communities for all citizens who are encouraged to live in peace and comfort. She issued a call for all residents in the various HDC communities to find amicable solutions to problems instead of resorting to violence.

Chairman of the HDC Noel Garcia and Managing Director of the HDC Jayselle McFarlane also expressed condolences to the family of the deceased and wished a speedy recovery to those who were injured during the attack.
